I am now processing the information I received back from the Ohio Chapter Presidents and ROTC/JROTC chairmen.

Contacted Compatriot David Perkins our NSSAR ROTC/JROTC Service Academies Liaison Chairman. Ask that I be the point of contact for Ohio ROTC/JROTC activities and communication. Asked and got the confirmation to send out David's Chairman Report to our State chapters.

Contacted Compatriot Roger Coursey our NSSAR ROTC/JROTC Service Academies Liaison Vice-Chairman concerning the Enhanced JROTC program. Rodger has sent me three documents about the program. The JROTC Application with Instructions (also posted on the NSSAR website under the ROTC/JROTC Committee); (2) 2020-2021 Enhanced JROTC Guidance; and (3) State JROTC Certification.

When submitting your completed cadet application package, Roger is asking that you also complete the State JROTC Certification sheet, provide it so that he may maintain better records of how the JROTC competition is progressing. Also, the deadline for submission of application package must be in his hands no later than 1 May 2021. **NOT** postmarked on that date, but in his hands.

I am in the process of reviewing the documents and will send them to our chapters soon.
