#### June 1, 2020 to October 11, 2020

Abraham Paik from the Western Reserve Society was our 2020 winner of the Ohio Society D.G. High / Joseph S. Rumbaugh Historical Oration Contest. Abigail Bozigar from the John Hancock Chapter placed second. Abraham received our \$800 First Place Award and Abigail received our \$400 Second Place Award.

Abraham competed in a virtual NSSAR 2020 SAR Joseph S. Rumbaugh Historical Oration Contest due to the cancellation of the Richmond Congress. Abraham was named the NSSAR Joseph S. Rumbaugh Historical Oration National Champion. He received the national 1<sup>st</sup> place cash prize of \$6,000.
