Patriot Graves Registration Committee Activity Report

Fall Board of Management

October 17, 2020

We continue to research and upload data into the Patriot Graves Registry with October 10, 2020 being the most recent update to the OHSSAR Web Site information over the past five years. We have added 800 additional patriots to the registry since January 2019 and now all Ohio Counties have a Patriot burial site.

This information also includes a Native American, six Patriots of Color, eleven Women and more than 200 Patriots here to fore unknown in the NSSAR Registry, so there are now more than 2244 pages of data available for review.

Only a small percentage of those listed do not have the NSSAR "P" number and after uploading about 500 more names we will have completed this accounting for the Ohio Society with those Patriots buried in Ohio (estimated to be above 7000 total). In addition, more than 3000 Grave photos have been forwarded to the NSSAR Biography data uploading volunteers from Ohio Patriot's graves.

Since September 2019 the National Patriot Records Committee has requested Registry information include the Find a Grave Memorial # and Cemetery # with the Biographical date submitted, hence we will also include that date in the OHSSAR Registry moving forward.
